**Expression of Interest for hiring Consulting services
for Long Term Training and Capacity Building Strategy for
Cyclone Risk Mitigation**

1. This request for expression of interest follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) published in the United Nations Development Business website <http://www.devbusiness.com> on 3rd December, 2009 and Times of India on December 9,2009.
2. The Government of India has applied for a credit of US\$ 254 million equivalent from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the first phase of the National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) (Project ID No.: P092217), and it intends to apply the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services under this project.
3. Executive Director, National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM) now invites eligible firms to indicate their interest in providing the consultancy services for preparing Long Term Training and Capacity Building Strategy for Cyclone Risk Mitigation.
4. The objective of the study would be
 - To access the capacity gaps of stakeholders in all the phases of the Disaster Management Cycle,
 - Develop short and long term capacity development strategies,
 - Conduct training need analysis and develop training designs and modules for all relevant stakeholders with particular focus on the development of capacities of the State Government institutions and their functions to effectively reduce and manage the risks of cyclone in the coastal states and UTs.
5. The interested consultants must provide the following information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services:
 - a) Name, address, facsimile number, e-mail ID and website address.
 - b) Number of States in the country in which the Firm has branches/offices, giving full addresses of the branches/offices.
 - c) Organisational structure.
 - d) Short CVs of key staff of the firms with relevant experience in training and capacity building.
 - e) Details of relevant training and capacity building assignments undertaken during the last 5 years.
 - f) Details of experience of working with externally funded projects e.g. World Bank, ADB, etc.
