MINUTES OF 18th PROJECT STEERING COMMITTEE (PSC) MEETING OF NATIONAL CYCLONE RISK MITIGATION PROJECT (NCRMP) PHASE-I HELD AT NDMA BHAWAN, NEW DELHI ON 8th August, 2018.

The 18<sup>th</sup> Project Steering Committee (PSC) meeting of NCRMP (Phase-I) was held on 8th August, 2018 at NDMA Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Sh. R.K. Jain, Member, NDMA. List of officers present in the meeting is enclosed at Annexure-A.

A warm welcome was extended to all the participants including Phase-I States. This was followed by detailed agenda-wise presentation on the progress of the Project by State Project Implementation Units. On the basis of the discussions, the status and decisions arrived at in the meeting are as follows:

### Agenda Item I: Commissioning of Early Warning Dissemination System 3.

The Contract for supply/installation of EWDS equipment awarded to M/s. Larsen & Toubro by both States (AP& Odisha). TCIL is Knowledge Partner and TPQA Agency. Implementation Status is as under:

(a) Andhra Pradesh: Coverage in all the 09 Coastal Districts (Srikakulam, Vijayanagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Prakasam & Nellore). Out of total 255 sites, 33 sites having some issues are yet to be handed over to L&T. Licence for Sat-phones, Digital Mobile Radio (DMR) & Alert Sirens obtained from Department of Telecommunications (DoT). Procurement of material completed except Alert Sirens and 32 towers which are expected to be delivered by September 2018. Installation completed for procured material.

(b) L&T has placed purchase order to sub vendor M/s UMS for implementation of Location Based Alert System (LBAS).

Decision:

The issues related to 33 pending sites to be resolved at the earliest.

(ii) LBAS commissioning with BSNL by August, 2018 and with other Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) by September, 2018.

(iii) SPIU shall ensure installation, testing and commissioning of EWDS at all sites by October 2018.

(c) Odisha: Coverage in 06 Coastal Districts (Puri, Ganjam, Bhadrak, Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara and Balasore). All sites (161) made available for installation. It is noted that installation of available equipment is over. Licence for DMR, Satellite Phone & Alert Siren received. L&T has placed purchase order to sub vendor M/s UMS for implementation of Location Based Alert System.

#### Decision:

(i) SPIU may direct M/s L&T to expedite implementation of LBAS in coordination with Telecom Service Providers so that LBAS is made functional with BSNL by August, 2018 and with other TSPs by September,

- EWDS to be commissioned by September, 2018 in all respects. (ii)
- (iii) M/s TCIL to send team to carry out TPQA immediately.

AP has conducted requisite number of 219 training programme to train 10173 volunteers to Red Cross.

Odisha has conducted Basic Orientation Training for 309 MPCS . Shelter level trainings are under progress.

## Decision:

Odisha Shall complete the trainings under progress by November, 2018

# 6. Agenda Item IV: Installation of Lightning Arrestors

Andhra Pradesh: Lightning Arrestors to be provided in 24 MPCS only, tender floated and to be awarded by 30.09.2018.

#### Decision:

AP shall compete the work of installation of lightning arrestors by 30.11.2018, by utilising the savings under the project.

Odisha: Procurement plan for installation of lightning arrestors prepared and send to World Bank for clearance.

## Decision:

SPIU Odisha shall send proposal to NDMA/World Bank for installation of lightning arrestors in cyclone shelters (non-NCRMP) which are on coast line. Installation to be completed by Nov, 2018.

7. Agenda Item V : Handing Over of Multi Purpose Cyclone Shelters to Maintenance and Management Committees:

Andhra Pradesh: Handed over 155 out of 218 completed Cyclone Shelters to the Management Committees and Corpus Fund for 138 MPCS released @ Rs.5 lakh each.

Odisha: Handed over 300 out of 306 completed Cyclone Shelters to the Managing Committees and released Corpus Fund @ Rs.5 lakh each for 316 Cyclone Shelters.

**Decision**: States were requested to expedite handing over of completed Cyclone Shelters along with release of Corpus Fund by Sep, 2018.

8. Agenda Item VI : Regular Power Connection to MPCS by Andhra Pradesh and Odisha:

Andhra Pradesh:

Completed MPCS - 218

Power Connection provided --- 145

Balance at Survey / Application stage.

Odisha:

Completed MPCS

-- 306

Power connection provided -- 152

Balance at Survey / Application stage.

#### Decision:

Both AP & Odisha shall ensure power connection to all MPCS by 31st October, 2018.

# 9. Agenda Item VII: Procurement of Shelter Level Equipment:

### Andhra Pradesh

It was informed that tender is floated for procurement of Shelter Level Equipment- to be opened on 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2018.

**Decision:** Saving under completed works to be utilised by the state for providing Shelter Level Equipment by Nov.2018.

Odisha: Procurement of Shelter Level Equipment underway; award under process; and deliveries to be completed by November, 2018.

#### Decision:

State shall utilise outlay/saving available under project to provide Shelter Level Equipment.

#### Observation:

(i) Balance outlay for release in AP is Rs 49.16 Cr. whereas expenditure remaining to be incurred is Rs. 274.29 Cr. Similarly, for Odisha, balance

outlay for release is Rs 85.03 Cr and expenditure remaining to be incurred is Rs.193.64 Cr.

#### Decision:

Both the States were asked to give requirement of funds indicating (i) timeline for further release immediately. (ii)

SPIU AP shall resolve the matter regarding lack of fund availability with line department immediately.

Both States will furnish the awarded cost details of Component 'B'", sub-(iii) component wise(MPCS/Road/Bridges/Saline Embankments) at the earliest; in order to make an assessment regarding savings (if any) under Component B.

Both States need to augment monthly expenditure so as to ensure (iv) utilisation of unspent balance at the earliest and to achieve the targeted

objective of project before its closure.

Audit Report for FY 2017-18 awaited from Andhra and Odisha.

#### Decision:

Both the States to submit the Audit Report on priority.
