MINUTES OF 10th PROJECT STEERING COMMITTEE (PSC) MEETING OF NATIONAL CYCLONE RISK MITIGATION PROJECT (NCRMP) PHASE-II HELD AT NDMA BHAWAN, NEW DELHI on 12th October, 2018.

The 10th Project Steering Committee (PSC) meeting of NCRMP (Phasewas held on 12th October, 2018 under the Chairmanship of Sh. R.K. Jain, Member, NDMA. List of officers present in the meeting is enclosed at Annexure-A.

A warm welcome was extended by Member (RKJ) to all participants followed 2. by a presentation on brief status of implementation of project by AS&PD, NDMA.

Agenda I: Floating of RfP for Early Warning Dissemination System (EWDS)

(a) Knowledge Partner M/s PWC (for West Bengal), M/s TCIL (for Goa, Karnataka, Kerala and Maharashtra) and Gujarat State Disaster Management Authority (GSDMA) made presentation of Technology option/RFP. On the basis of the discussions, the decisions arrived at the meeting are as follows:

Decisions:

- (i) The procurement of EWDS to be done without Group Messaging & Mass Massaging/ Location Based Alert System (LBAS).
- (ii) Group/Mass Massaging to be procured through nation wide Common Alert Protocol (CAP) to be implemented by DOT/C-DOT.
- (iii) SPIUs may explore the option of using MPCS/Government buildings and Towers erected by Telecom Service Providers (TSP) for installation of Alert Sirens. However, location of Alert Siren should not be compromised.
- (iv) SPIUs should go ahead with the RFP irrespective of the fact that the Cost Estimates exceed outlay.

- (v) Environment, Health and Safety (EHS) guidelines to be included in DPR/RfP Documents by Knowledge Partners.
- (vi) The guideline issued vide minutes of the meeting held on 08/10/2018 with knowledge Partner/World Bank/SPIUs should be kept in view which finalising the RFP.
- (b) Based upon above following timelines were agreed upon by SPIU/Knowledge Partners.
