MINUTES OF 20TH PROJECT STEERING COMMITTEE (PSC) MEETING OF NATIONAL CYCLONE RISK MINITGATION PROJECT (NCRMP) PHASE-II HELD THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING WITH STATES/SPIUS AT NDMA BHAWAN, NEW DELHI ON 20TH AUGUST, 2020 (11:00 AM).

The 20th Project Steering Committee (PSC) meeting of NCRMP (Phase-II) was held at 11 AM on 20th August, 2020 under the Chairmanship of Sh. G V V Sarma, Member Secretary, NDMA. List of participants in the meeting is enclosed at Annexure-A.

2. A warm welcome was extended by the Chairman to all participants followed by a presentation on status of implementation of project by the SPIUs through VC. On the basis of the presentation by SPIUs and discussions, the decisions arrived at the meeting are as follows:

Agenda III: Strengthening of existing infrastructure such as school etc. to make them fit for use as cyclone shelters (New Sub-component under Component B):-

- (i) Proposals had been sought from the SPIUs. Goa has suggested taking up of 274 existing schools and Maharashtra has suggested taking up of 810 schools with an estimated cost of Rs. 78 Crores and Rs. 280 Crores respectively. Maharashtra and Karnataka have also proposed construction of new MPCS.
- (ii) After detailed deliberation and keeping in view the availability of financial resources under NCRMP II, it was decided that the SPIUs may take up only strengthening of existing infrastructure and the number/target in this regard would

be twice the number of MPCS planned under NCRMP II. Accordingly, the target/number to each SPIUs will be as under:-

- (iii) The SPIUs were advised to undertake gap analysis and prepare DPRs. It was clarified that tendering/award of works will be as per World Bank procurement norms. All these location/sites will be within 10 Km of the coastline.
- (iv) PMU in consultation with World Bank will circulate broad guidelines for doing gap analysis and preparation of DPR. SPIUs will make earnest efforts to prepare DPR/bid documents and tender out the works by 30th September 2020.

Agenda IV and V: Action Plan for Procurement & Installation of Lightning Arrestors with structures and Coastal Belt Shelter Plantation:-

(i) It was decided that under this Sub-component, Lightning Arrester will be fitted only on (I) existing Bus shelter structure, (II) Newly constructed Bus shelter structure, and (III) Existing Gram Panchayat building and all these structures should be located within 10 KM of coastline. The ceiling cost for these works will be as under:

A. For Lightning Arrester alone to be fitted on existing structure (Bus Shelter, Gram Panchayat Building) – Rs. 50,000/- .

B. For newly constructed Bus shelter with Lightning Arrester- Rs. 5 Lakh.

 (ii) It was further decided by the committee to allocate the lumpsum outlay of Rs. 185.39 Cr. in respect of coastal shelter belt plantation & installation of Lightning Arrester to various states as under:

Agenda VI: Procurement of Shelter Equipment for MPCS:-

- (i) As decided during the 19th PSC meeting, the list of items/equipment (38 nos) have been firmed up in consultation with the World Bank. The estimated cost of these equipments is about Rs 20 Lakh per MPCS.
- (ii) It was decided to allocate Rs. 20.00 Lakh per MPCS for procurement of shelter equipment by the SPIUs.
- (iii) The Chair (Member Secretary) stressed upon the importance of community participation/ownership (through CSMMC) for management and maintenance of cyclone shelters, as also for managing/regulating the use and upkeep of shelter equipments and observed that CSMMC should be formed/guidelines formulated well ahead of the completion of MPCS.

It was informed that PMU (NDMA) has sought extension of timeline (of NCRMP II) from MHA, and SPIUs were urged to conclude tendering process and award of balance works, expedite pace of execution of ongoing works and utilization of the funds.

It was also impressed upon SPIUs that since the project (NCRMP II) is originally slated for closures in March 2021, activities/ expenditure spilling over beyond March 2021 will be exclusively on State Government Account, in the event of proposed extension of time line not materializing.
