The interested consultants must provide the following information indicating that they are qualified to perform the required services,

- (i) The organization shall provide its name, address, facsimile number, e-mail ID and website address.
- (ii) The organization shall provide the number of Coastal States/ UTs in the country in which the firm has branches/offices, giving full addresses of the branches/offices.
- (iii) The organization shall furnish information regarding the year wise annual turnover for the last five years. A certificate to this effect from a Chartered Accountant, in original, must be submitted.
- (iv) The organization shall also provide details of organizational structure & availability of key staff of the firm with relevant experience in similar projects and their qualifications.
