Expression of Interest for Appointment of Consultant for Benefit Monitoring and Evaluation Study.

1. This request for expression of interest follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) published in the United Nations Development Business (UNDB) website <http://www.devbusiness.com/> on December 3, 2009 and the Times of India on December 9, 2009.
2. Government of India has applied for a credit of US\$ 255 million towards the cost of National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP-1), and the Government of India intends to apply the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services under this project.
3. National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project-1 is to be implemented in the States of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha and has the following components:
 - Component A** – Last Mile Connectivity for the dissemination of cyclone warnings and advisories from district/sub-district level to communities and vice versa. This will be implemented by NDMA in consultation with participating States/UTs.
 - Component B** - Construction of physical infrastructure for cyclone risk mitigation. This Component will be implemented by the States/UTs.
 - Component C** - Technical assistance for capacity building on hazard risk management. NDMA and National Institute of Disaster Management are the implementation agencies for this component.
 - Component D**- Project Management and Monitoring applicable to all implementing agencies.
4. Project Management Unit, NCRMP, NDMA, now invites eligible firms to indicate their interest in providing the consultancy services for carrying out the Benefit Monitoring and Evaluation Study based on the Key Programme Indicators developed for the Project to measure Project outcomes/results. The Study will be taken up in three phases – initially for a baseline, during mid-term and at the end of the Project period (2015). It will incorporate both quantitative and qualitative analyses.
5. The interested organization must provide necessary information to indicate that they are qualified to perform the services including the details of offices in India, number of senior level staff with relevant experience, details of similar Projects executed especially with external assistance, turnover etc. with supporting documents as per details in the project web site

www.ncrmp.gov.in and NDMA`s website www.ndma.gov.in Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications.
