PROCEEDINGS OF PROJECT STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING OF NATIONAL CYCLONE RISK MITIGATION PROJECT (NCRMP) PHASE-II FOR QUARTER ENDING 30th SEPTEMBER, 2015 HELD ON 16th NOVEMBER, 2015.

The Project Steering Committee meeting of the National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) Phase-II was held under the chairmanship of Sh. R.K. Jain, Member Secretary, NDMA on 16th November, 2015 to review the Status of Project. A list of participants is placed at Annexure-A.

After a brief welcome address, a detailed presentation as per agenda items listed for discussion was made by Project Director, PMU, NCRMP. Based upon detailed deliberations on agenda items, following decisions were taken:

2.1. Status of Constitution of Project Implementation Unit (PIU) and deployment / hiring of staff, Constitution of State Project Steering Committee (SPSC):

It was informed by all the States that PIUs have been constituted and Project Directors are in place. They were impressed upon that PDs should now play pro-active role in taking forward the project implementation, if need be, in consultation with PMU, NCRMP, NDMA and the World Bank. All the States have constituted Project Steering Committee wherein preparatory measures to kick start the Project have been deliberated. The States were requested that these Committees must meet on quarterly basis for smooth implementation of the project and removing any bottlenecks in project implementation. Need to strengthen PIUs at States by deployment of necessary staff/Specialist at the earliest was emphasised upon.

2.2. Discussion regarding implementation of Component-A:

This Component is at the advance stage of implementation in the States of AP and Odisha. PD, PMU, NCRMP, NDMA informed that the Technology Option developed by TCIL have already been shared with Phase-II States. RFP floated by Phase-I States

shall also be shared with Phase-II States for their guidance. Phase-II States are required to kick start consultation with the stake holders in their respective States on the issues of technology, implementation strategy as needed for their States.

2.3. Status of Subcomponent-wise site finalization/Environment Clearance (EC) for Cyclone Risk Mitigation Infrastructure (CRMI) under Component-B:

2.5. Scope of Component-C and methodology to be adopted for initiating studies:

2.7. Requirement of financial statements:

States who have been allotted funds under NCRMP Phase-II are required to submit Interim Unaudited Financial Report (IUFR) including Utilization Certificate (UC) on quarterly basis beginning from December, 2015 (i.e IUFR for quarter ending December, 2015 to be submitted latest by 15th January, 2016).

2.8. Action required regarding claiming of Retroactive Expenses:

The IUFR/UC for any expenditure incurred under project with effect from April, 2014 up to July, 2015 need to be submitted separately under retroactive financing in one lot.

9. Any other item with the permission of the chair.

- It was felt that PSC meeting for the quarter ending December, 2015 may be held at Andhra Pradesh, preferably at Vishakhapatnam to enable Phase-II States to get first hand idea of various works done in Phase-I.
- All the States were requested to adhere to MHA sanction order No. 47-01/2012-DM-III/1366-1380 dated 24th January, 2015 regarding physical/financial outlay with no deviations.
- States were requested to finalize TPQA/Internal & External Audit agencies in line with requirements specified as per Finance Management Manual (FMM) already shared by PMU, NCRMP, NDMA.

States may start updation of MIS available at www.ncrmp.mis.gov.in after award of works/deployment of IT Manager. In this regard, PMU may provide further training/guidance.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
