The meeting to review progress under Component B of the study "Design of National Seismic Risk Mitigation Programme (NSRMP)" under NCRMP (Phase II) was held on 02nd January, 2020 at 3 PM under the Chairmanship of Dr. Pradeep Kumar, Spl. Secretary & Project Director, NDMA. The meeting was attended by Officials from NDMA, the World Bank and the Consultant (M/s DDF-AKDN JV). List of participants is attached at Annexure-I.

- 2. The meeting started with a welcome note from the Spl. Secretary & Project Director, NDMA. A presentation was made by the Consultant Team on overall progress achieved so far under Component B of NSRMP, especially in terms of meetings held in the project States/UTs and data/information received from the project States/UTs.
- 3. After deliberation involving views/suggestions of participants, following decisions were taken:
 - i. Rapid Visual Screening (RVS) will be done for 3500 buildings/infrastructure out of which 1750 buildings/infrastructure will be retrofitted. Accordingly, DPR will be prepared for 1750 buildings/infrastructure. The tentative break up is as under:

ii. Detailed Vulnerability Assessment (DVA) will be carried out alongwith RVS of critical buildings/infrastructure and progress on RVS will be reported to PMU on weekly basis.

- iii. Model DPR (Structure specific/Typology wise) to be submitted by the Consultant by 1st week of March, 2020 or as early as possible for review by Experts.
- iv. The Consultant will endeavour to expedite Kick off workshop in Manipur State, at the earliest.
- v. Team Leader, State Coordinator, Associate State Coordinator and Structural Engineering Specialist will attend every meeting related to NSRMP in the project States/UTs, with atleast 7 days advance notice to PMU, NDMA for any meeting in the State.
- vi. Tourist facilities (Tourism buildings/structures), one in each district particularly in case of Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh States to be included under B 1 Category.
- vii. In case of Uttarakhand State, Bridge and TDU to be confirmed from the State and buildings/infrastructure under Category B2 & B3 to be worked out in consultation with the State.
- viii. Buildings/infrastructure under Category B2 to be added in the list in case of Assam State.
- ix. PPT for future presentation should be hyperlinked with relevant documents/slides detailing relevant data/information related to different Components of NSRMP.
- x. Some building/structure to be considered in every category.
- xi. Seismic resistance status of Power Grid Stations to be confirmed the concerned Officials of Electricity Deptt. in the States/UTs. PMU to be intimated for participation in the related meeting.
- xii. Prioritization of buildings/infrastructures to be retrofitted will be done in consultation with States/UTs.
- xiii. In case of Bihar State, buildings/infrastructure under Category B3 and overhead Tank to be included in priority list in consultation with the State.
- xiv. List of critical buildings/infrastructure should be in order as given in ToR (enclosed).
- xv. State Coordinators will give feedback to the Prl. Secretary/the highest level functionaries in the Deptt.
- xvi. In case of UT of J&K, Fire Station to be included in the priority list and Consultant Team will coordinate with the team of World Bank project "JTFRP" for detailed relevant data to be incorporated in the list.
- xvii. Data received from States/UTs to be verified by State specific coordinator. Information of Helipad received from Meghalaya State to be verified.
- xviii. State-wise prioritization list under different Categories to be prepared.
- 4. The meeting ended with thanks to the Chair and all the participants.
